Hungarian as a Foreign Language 1

To be performed at the same time as Hungarian as a foreign language 2. and Hungarian as a foreign language 3. **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS****BBI-HUN-102**

**COURSE DESCRIPTIONS****BBI-HUN-110
Oral Communication 1**

The goal of the course is to improve Hungarian conversational skills. Great emphasis is placed on demonstrating authentic language, acquiring the phrases, expressions, and structures of the spoken language, as well as developing pragmatic competence. Students become familiar with linguistic behavioral patterns associated with various speech situations. They are also continuously facilitated to expand their vocabulary of the sequential topics.

Students are put into groups according to their placement test results.

**COURSE DESCRIPTIONS****BBI-HUN-111
Written Communication 1**

The aim of the course is to develop writing skills and discourse competence, which is achieved gradually using various sequential tasks. Following the appropriate methodological guidelines, students create different types of texts and text elements and perform various tasks (completion, transformation, etc.) with them. Classes are also devoted to practicing linking words and phrases. Great emphasis is placed on developing students' competence not only in creative writing, but in genres that they can utilize in their everyday lives, such as e-mails, applications and motivational letters.

Students are put into groups according to their placement test results.

**COURSE DESCRIPTIONS****BBI-HUN-112
Media Language 1**

The aim of the course is to develop students' reading comprehension in Hungarian, as well as to familiarize them with the language and vocabulary of the mass communication culture, which is of primary importance nowadays. During the semester, students are exposed to authentic audio-visual materials of various genres (news broadcast, interview, documentary, commercial, etc.) and newspaper articles, in order to facilitate their deeper understanding of the Hungarian media language. The class includes activities about the internet, which enable students to learn the expressions connected to this topic. Great emphasis is placed on the methodologically appropriate analysis and interpretation of texts.

**COURSE DESCRIPTIONS****BBI-HUN-120
Cultural Studies 1**

The aim of the course is to expand the knowledge related to Hungarian culture, history and the natural geography of Hungary, as well as a more in-depth, professional systematization of this knowledge.
